Weekend Intensive Workshop - Encaustics with Kim Bernard

Sat and Sun Oct 11 & 12 from 9am to 5pm

Encaustic technique dates back to the 5th Century BC. As a contemporary medium it's a versatile method of painting with a molten beeswax based paint. In this weekend intensive learn to prepare supports, mix new colors, apply wax, fuse, etch, layer, combine collage, transfer copied images & incorporate found objects into encaustic pieces. Pre-registration required. **Fee:** \$225 plus \$65 materials fee

To inform the local community about the unique qualities of encaustics, Bernard will give a talk open to the public on techniques and materials, with samples of her work and discussion on Saturday 10/11 at 7 pm. \$7 at the door
